Executive Summary

Ending an amazing Quarter for Asia and Oceania Regions, VATSIM introduces the new network structure with the creation of 3 new Regional VP positions, reforming the six Regions into three. As such, Asia and Oceania become one Region, Asia Pacific. The new logo of the region is almost finalized, estimated date to be announced is within November. We are currently finalizing the new organizational chart for APAC Region. There will be recruitment in the next weeks to fulfill key positions to assist on the consistent growth of the Region. In the meantime, Han Cui remains Regional Membership Manager to assist with member retention and tickets. The site of former VATSIM Asia Region is under reconstruction to reflect APAC Region, while a new url is ready to replace the old one. Overall ATC activity and training has been increased, we have seen new ATC joining at VATWA, VATSEA, VATROC, VATPRC, VATPAC and VATNZ with the later introducing a new training structure. There have been numerous events organized across the Region with great success, VATPRC starring with events each week and VATSEA with the light up” series. We are looking forward for the possibility of intercontinental events on a bigger scale more frequently, as well as introducing a possible Region Light Up as the ultimate goal. Plans will be discussed In the near future. VATJPN is also building a new P1 training system and has also been very active with joint events. VATSEA decided to use the new HQ separately from VATWA due needs. ATC activity increased remarkably at India, Sri Lanka-Maldives and Pakistan vACCs. New staff additions for Indonesia, Pakistan, Sri Lanka-Maldives as well as new mentors for India vACC.

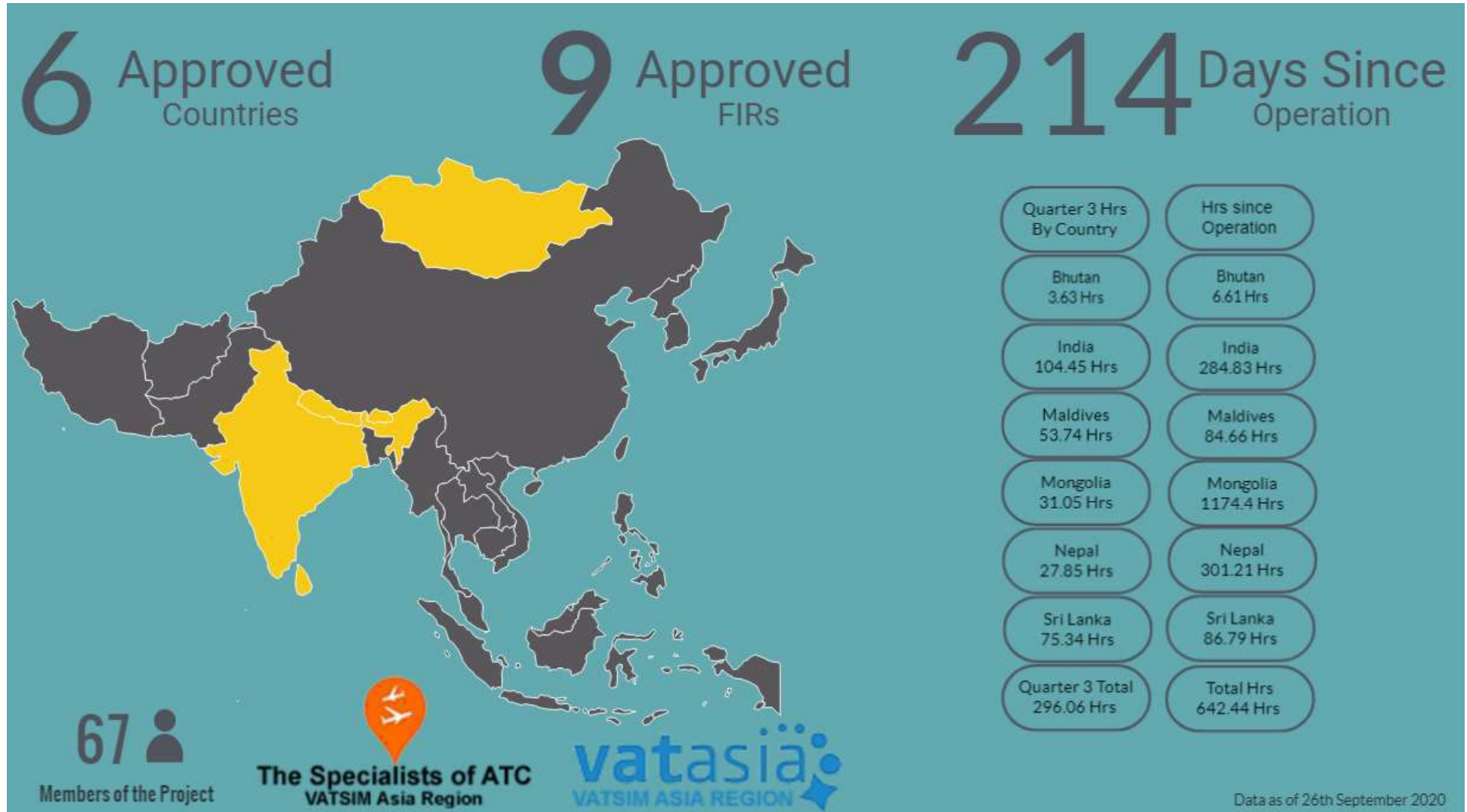

We thank Damien for all of his hard work.

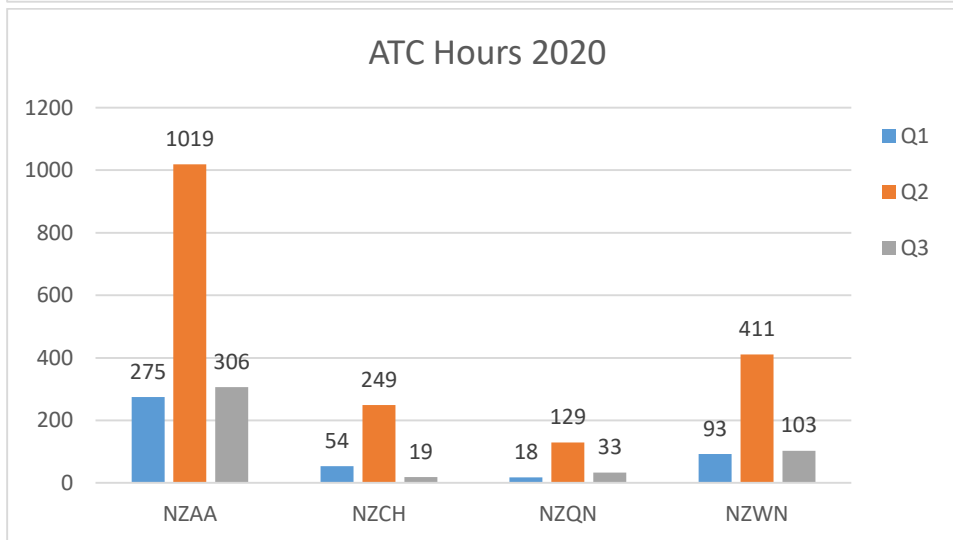
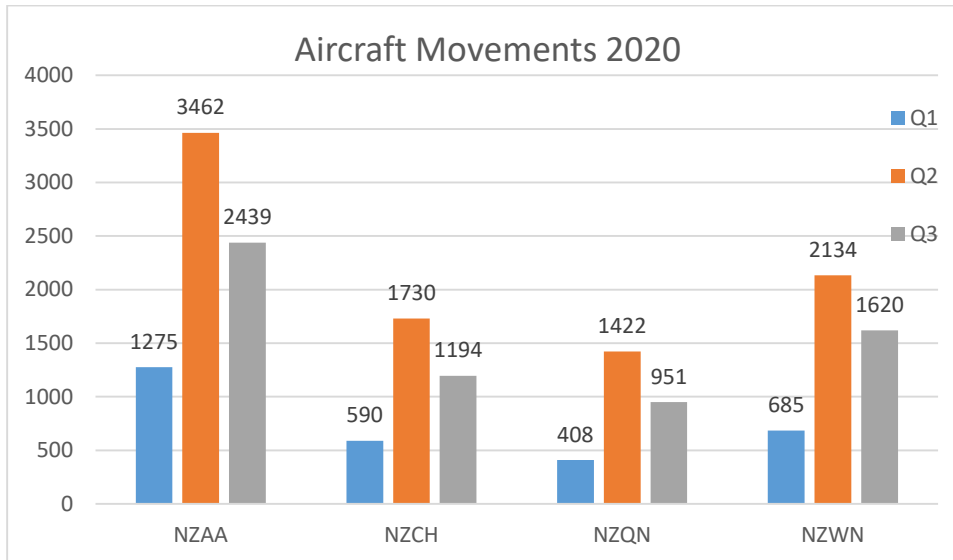
2.0 Membership

Hong Kong vACC

Overall

We experience difficulties training C3 controllers. We are told training for C3 is placed on hold because the division has no capacity so no new C3 or instructor can be trained at Hong Kong VACC currently. Other than that, huge progress was made for training and events.

We want to motivate people to work and contribute to VATSIM. While we cannot provide monetary awards to the volunteers, things such as “Senior Controller” ratings and “Senior Manager” titles are the best that we can do, and we should motivate people by continuing these recognitions even through this hard time. That is why we are asking for a clear timeline as to when the C3 training can be resumed at the division level.

That brings to the next point. There is a rating system in place to motivate people to progress. If nobody is a “rating chaser”, then we all would not have been where we are today with our controller ratings and skills. This is the same with the pilot rating system, which has been recently revamped to reflect the needs of VATSIM today and is something that is constantly updating. That motivates pilots to improve their skills and continue to fly in the sky. It will also motivate some to refine their skills so much that they will become a mentor to other new pilots in the sky. When we tell people that the top (namely C3) cannot be reached for an indefinite period of time, would people be as motivated to work or even be interested in staying in the division while other places provide that opportunity? Yes, it is a loophole that people can transfer elsewhere for higher ratings and then transfer back here, but if they are so eager to get it, who am I to stop them?


