



Asia Pacific Region - REPORT Q4/2020- APAC

Executive Summary

Year 2020 is closing with major updates within APAC Region. The new logo of APAC is ready and published, accompanied with guidelines usage. VATSEA is also updating the division logo, with estimated release Q1/2021.

The temporary site of APAC is hosted at the old URL of former VATASIA Region. There is work being done to update and migrate URLs. Estimated completion within Q1/2021. The same applies for The Specialists of ATC site. A new helpdesk with Frequent Asked Questions will also be implemented.

The organizational chart of the Region is ready and will be published together with the new site. APAC Discord is now fully functional. Overall activity and growth is stable and rising the last quarters at various areas of the Region, new staff appointments make their appearance at vACC and Division level (Malaysia, Indonesia, Philippines vACC-VATWA-VATPAC). Myanmar vACC is one of the ongoing projects of VATSEA to develop. There have been a series of small and large scale events, across the Region organized by all Divisions, including events for new members who joined and connected for first time. All Divisions and vACCs organized events on weekly basis. WorldFlight passage was smooth and well organized in terms of ATC coverage and traffic flow by local teams. ATC online activity has increased since last year's adjacent quarter. VATNZ has doubled the online ATC hours, from 2000h (year 2019) to 4000h in total for year 2020 and 25,000 a/c movements recorded. VATNZ has introduced new ATC courses for resident and visiting controllers. There has been a large increase of new ATC rated members at all Divisions, especially in VATSEA, with 45 rating upgrades with VATPAC, VATKOR, VATJPN, VATWA following closely. VATPAC changeover technology to AWS infrastructure and have introduced ATC training plan for 2021. Discussion regarding update of the constitution took place with possible updates during Q1-2021. Operationally, data and documentation is maintained and updated frequently. VATPAC had new staff additions within this Quarter. The Division has proven is one step ahead regarding events, a list of planned events for 2021 has been prepared already and can be found under section 4.3.1 of VATPAC report.

Finally, we would like to immensely thank the Divisions and members for their contribution into translating the New Members Orientation document to native languages.

There have been overall 247 tickets (of which 114 via the ticket system and including email transfer requests) submitted on Regional level for year 2020. All members have received membership retention and guidance.

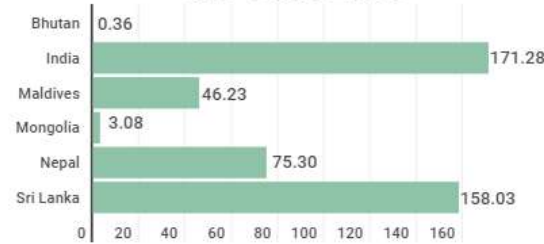

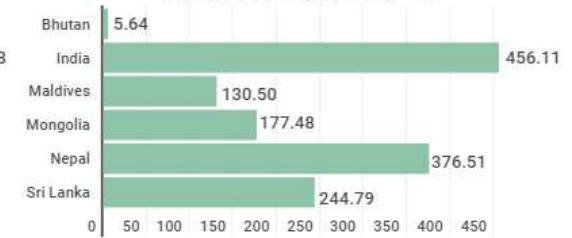

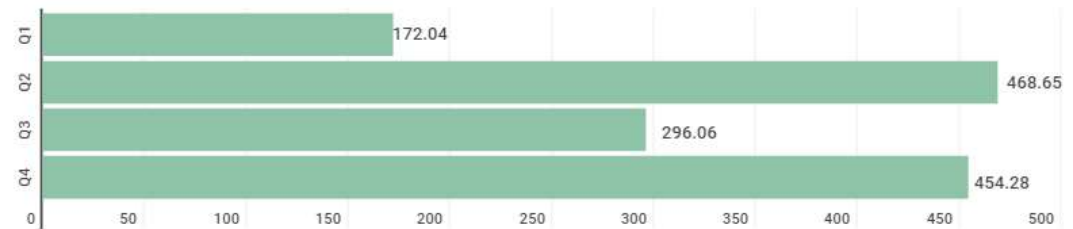

VATNZ QUARTERLY REPORT Q4 2020

Executive Summary

The 4th quarter for 2020 rounded off what was quite an impressive year for the division.

There was a dramatic increase in ATC hours logged by our controllers, rising from over 2000hrs in 2019 to just over 4000hrs in 2020.

Aircraft movements were also greatly increased with over 25000 recorded.

Of course this was certainly not a normal year with the country in various levels of lockdown, but we did also see the release a new version of flight simulator which may explain some of the increases.

It will be interesting to see how 2021 measures up.

Due to real life commitments Oliver Holmwood had to step down from his board role. The board will be seeking a replacement as soon as possible in the new year.

Membership

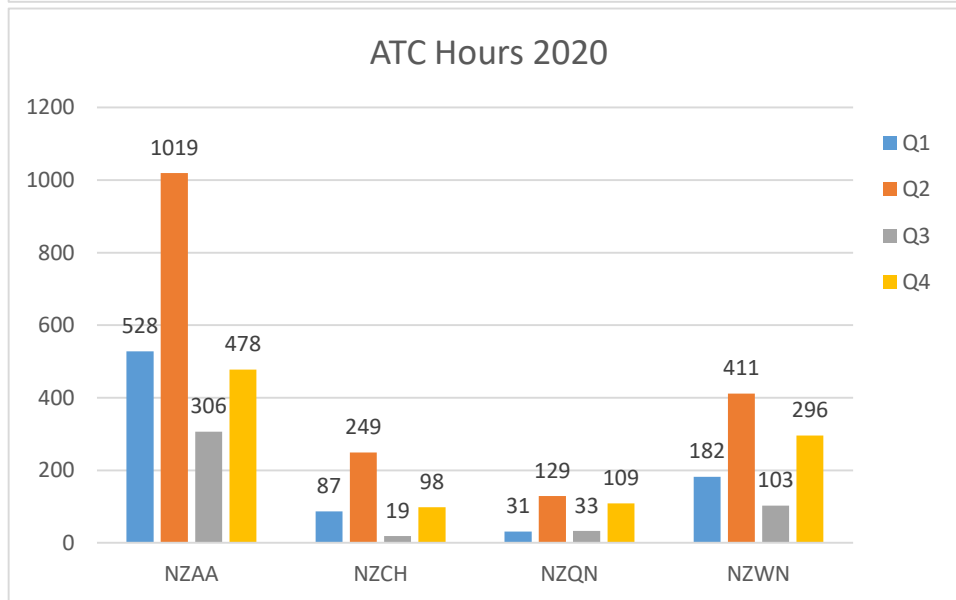
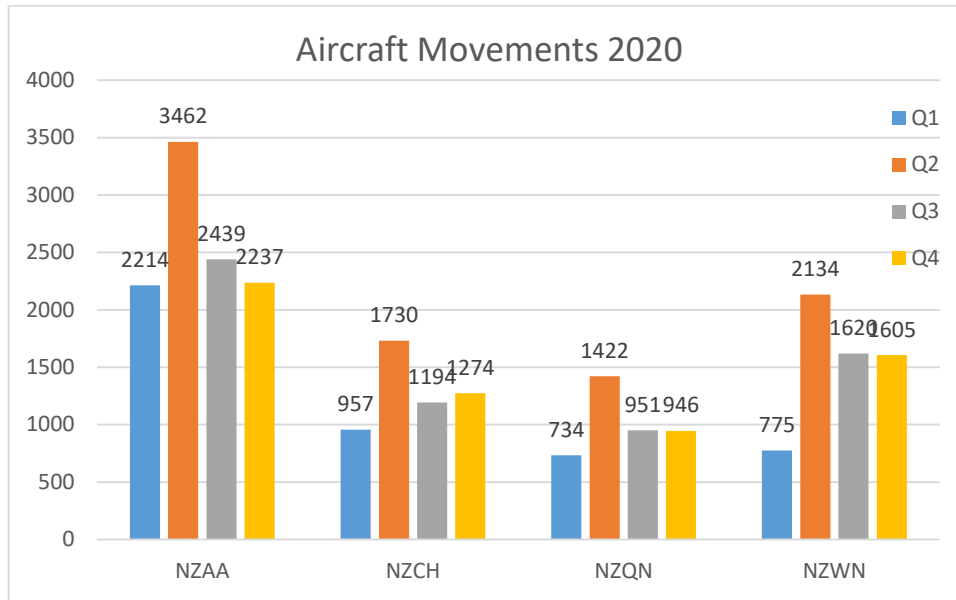
At the time of writing VATNZ membership stood at 662 so another small increase in the quarter up from 641.

Currently only 286 are active. Active is defined by our systems as having flown or controlled within VATNZ airspace in the last 180 days.

Operational Report

Region Activity

Our regions 4 major airports are used as a measure of activity. Each quarter is shown left to right Q1 though Q4



As previously mentioned this year has seen a large increase in ATC hours and aircraft movements within our airspace during the year.

Total ATC hours for 2020 was 4078, this seems largely due to the covid lockdown in April 2020 which saw a huge increase in online activity.

Aircraft movements totaled 25694 which was up from 19300 in 2019.

Furthermore, the quarter also saw a change in requirements for gaining a controller rating.

The new requirements are as follows:

S2: 50 hours total VATSIM time with 20 of those hours included in the requirement of which must be observing

S3: 50 hours, three towered aerodromes over a period of no less than one month

C1: 50 hours, three TMA positions over a period of no less than one month

Updates

Q4 saw many new projects come to life and getting released into the community. Q4 saw four new courses being released for the community's use. These being the brand-new Tower, TMA, and Enroute Visiting Controller courses as well as VATNZs Pacific Oceanic Agreement course. I am quite excited to see visiting controller applications coming through and getting local C1s interesting in oceanic controlling.

In the later stages of Q4, vatSys NZ profile was released to the community. vatSys brings VATNZ controllers one step closer to having a realistic controller client which functions just like the real thing.

Over Q1/2 2021, VATNZ controllers will be slowly migrating to vatSys with ATC Training being the preferred client for use with ATC training. vatSys is being continued to be developed with new features being added to every AIRAC cycle. I would like to thank Oliver, Alex, Tom, and anyone else who has had the profile during the closed beta for their help in the development and getting this project to where it is at. The training department is continuing to update assessment processes and aims to have the new assessments implemented by the start of Q3 2021.

Lastly, in Q1 2021 we will be releasing new SOPs and positions for VATNZ controllers. These being NZOH_APP and changes to NZCM_FSS. Keep an eye out for NOTAM changes in Q1 2021.

vACC reports

Hong Kong vACC

Overall

Hong Kong VACC sees a decline in the number of traffic received in all aerodromes in Q4 as many younger members return to school for the semester compared to Q2 and Q3 of the year. However, we continued to see a trend of more and more “streaming pilots” who use fly in groups. This is changing the pattern of traffic activity and the interaction between the VACC and pilots. The marketing and streamer relations departments will continue to leverage this new trend to provide better service to the community.

In terms of training, a meeting was organized with VATSEA management in November to discuss the ongoing status of training and other affairs. A subsequent VACC staff meeting was organized in December to follow some of the items. The management concluded that a restructuring of the S1 and S2 training courses is overdue, and the team observed noticeable discrepancy in the training outcome of different mentors and instructors, leading to some students taking significantly longer time for training than others. As a result, two assistant managers have been appointed to take charge and address this rework. During this period, training of S1 and S2 is halted until the new training courses are rolled out on Moodle. S3 training course is still under construction under Moodle but a 5-hour seminar was held in late October so that a new batch of S3 trainees could begin their training. C1 training course will begin construction on Moodle in late December.

In Q4 we organized a good number of events welcoming pilots from around the world. Thanks to our donors, we are able to organize giveaway during some of these events to attract more pilots and to make the overall experience more fun for the pilots.

Pandemic situation in Hong Kong has been unstable and all physical events have been Postponed However arrangements for local gathering for the CTP have been successfully arranged before the fourth wave of pandemic. 3.1 *Welcome*

ZF opened the meeting at 0921UTC on the VATPAC discord and thanked everyone for their attendance.

3.5 *Matters Arising from the Previous Meeting*

3.5.1 Technology Changeover to AWS

TG confirmed that everything has been moved to AWS infrastructure except the forums and the front page. ZF and GB queried why the other sites had not been moved yet and TG expressed concerns about downtime and impact on members. ZF and TG will do forums on the night of this meeting and front page to come shortly thereafter.

3.5.2 vatSys Training for ATC Instructors and Mentors

GB confirmed that “train the trainer” sessions have not occurred he pointed out that all training staff are now proficient vatSys users. GB will double check with the team and confirm if any additional training is required.

3.5.3 Training Staff Availability and Contribution Levels

GB stated that he has reminded all staff this week about availability and activity requirements. Some small changes will be made to the team and announced shortly. Will also look to recruit some new mentors.

3.5.4 Event Coordinator

TG confirmed that this was completed.

3.5.5 Implement RealOps System

TG confirmed that the RealOps system was set up and used on the new AWS infrastructure.

3.6 *New Business*

3.6.1 2021 ATC Training Plan

GB stated that the the 2021 plan was still in development but that more importantly, the current priority is to execute and complete the 2020 plan. This should be completed by May 2021 and was composed by previous Director ATC Training Cam Tyson. GB also stated that the ATC Training Policy was put to the board for comment and will also be put up for community consultation. The Procedural Tower course progressing very well thanks to some hard work from Matt and Brett. The Oceanic endorsement course is completed and ready for 'production'. The Sydney course was still in a planning phase and actual content writing has not been started yet and the need for this will be reviewed. Mentoring files are also being reviewed as well as the lesson plans. Longer term goals include updating much of the training material to suit vatSys related changes and implementing the new Senior Controller course.

3.6.2 Staff movements

GB confirmed that the ATC Standards Manager role remained vacant and that he will continue to discuss options with any applicants as well as existing training staff.

3.6.3 Training management system

ZF queried status of the ATC Training Management system being created by Will Smart. TG confirmed that he still needed to provide Will with appropriate access. This would be done ASAP.

ACTION ITEM: TG to provide WS with access to ensure system can be appropriately set up.

3.6.4 Senior Controller Rating Policy

ZF explained the overview and purpose behind the new Senior Controller Policy. ZF moved a motion that the policy been enacted by vote.

4 votes yay, 0 votes nay; the motion passes.

ACTION ITEM: ZF to publish the Senior Controller Policy.

3.6.5 Document Control

TG has drafted a document control policy. TG explain the policy to the board. GB noted it is a bit complicated, but it is important that some (but not all) documents are controlled and versioned properly. TG will look to set up an open-source Quality Management System to assist with document management. ZF queried about the current use of the Google Drive system. Maybe it needs a clean and re-organise.

TG brought up a small change to the constitution prior to it's new version being brought into force.

TG moved that section 14 (2) (d) of the Constitution be changed to "enact policies". Seconded ZF.

This change will allow any member of VATPAC to create/make a policy, but the board is responsible for reviewing and enacting said policies.

3.6.6 Technology Department Structure

TG expressed the importance of properly recording project documentation and scope to prevent ideas getting lost as people move on and new people come in. TG has begun to create thread in the forums for current projects and will ensure this procedure is being followed as new developers are brought on and projects are created.

3.6.7 Support System

TG said the technology department is currently using Atlassian support software. ZF asked TG to check about possible crossover with membership and suggested a possible other solution is required – maybe an open-source solution and something that covers all departments.

ACTION ITEM: ZF and TG to investigate and liaise with membership.

3.6.8 Staff Policy

TG pointed out that we still have not enacted a staff policy. ZF needs to do this. TG reminded it must include a section on acceptable use of IT systems.

ACTION ITEM: ZF to draft policy prior to Q1 2021 meeting.

3.6.9 Membership Census

SC confirmed that once access his is sorted to CERT/Terminal a membership census will be conducted to hopefully re-invigorate lost members. ZF commented that SC will be well-placed to do this, having been away from the hobby for some time. Membership meeting to take place shortly and a plane to be constructed for 2021 and beyond.

3.6.10 DCRM Role Vacant

Greg queried the state of the DCRM position. VATSIM would not approved Callum Strawbridge as the DCRM. VATSIM will hopefully provide a shortlist for review by ZF but ZF commented that further changes to the CoR could take place changing the structure of the Conflict Resolution System and removing the involvement of the division all-together. VATSIM will be covering any DCRM related issues in the meantime.

3.6.11 Constitution enacted

ZF summarised the changes to the constitution which was modified after a 30-day public comment window. ZF moved a motion that the constitution been enacted by vote.

4 votes yay, 0 votes nay.

GB reviewed the constitution which then resulted in the confirmation that a motion to change the constitution could not pass unless all board members were present. A special board meeting would need to be convened or wait until Q1 2021.

The information reflected in this document now more accurately represents real world operations, largely to do with the implementation of the new parallel runway. Please take the time to read through these documents when they are released, as a fair amount of new information has been made available. There will be an announcement in the discord and the forums when they are made available.

A lot has been happening in the IT department behind the scenes with a new pathway forward being reached. An announcement at the start of new year is expected to come from the department that establishes a new direction for the department.

4.4.1 Department restructure

With the restructure of VATPAC, the IT department has been looking inward to how it can improve efficiency and capabilities. Two new positions are created within the department, Development Manager and Systems & Support Manager. The latter of the two has already been filled by Sam Wilson and we are looking forward to seeing the capabilities that he will be able to bring to the department.

4.4.2 Move to AWS

A large number of the VATPAC services have been transferred to AWS with only a few services remaining.

4.4.3 VATPAC Core v2

We have been looking into upgrades to our web services for VATPAC Core v2, expecting to use Amazon's Web Services (AWS). Core v2 will be the backend of VATPAC's services, and it will be the one place for all management and permissions. By using AWS, we are able to have:

- Lower management costs, as we are paying by usage rather than a fixed fee

- Greater security and privacy, with Amazon's own dedicated issues management team and superior storage of confidential data by AWS
- Serverless Architecture, meaning Amazon finds the best available server to serve the requested content
- Greater efficiency, with faster response times from AWS servers and negligible downtime
- Easier management, as AWS services are all managed by one simple control panel, as well as the ability to dynamically change server requirements.

At the moment, we are looking to move VATPAC Core onto AWS services which will allow for a trial of AWS. This also removes some workload off the Vultr server and may allow for a downgrade in Vultr to save costs. VATPAC Core v2 will also allow for better interactivity with the community and better extensibility for third parties and API access.

4.4.4 Pilot Assist and vatSys

We are currently developing the new Pilot Assist and ensuring Vatpac's IT infrastructure will support the new vatSys Client!

Unfortunately due the voluntary nature of VATPAC staff, progress on pilot assist has significantly slowed. We are looking to further push the project capabilities with the beginning of the year.

We are also working with the members of the vatSys team to ensure it is fully supported by the IT Department and Operations Department for full release.
